



# Livable Bathrooms Washbasins in Public Accessible Bathrooms



Researchers at UNSW Sydney and GWA Caroma are seeking volunteer research participants to learn about the space requirements of wheelchair users at public accessible washbasins.

### WHO?

If you are a person who uses a wheelchair for community access, over 18 years of age, live within 50km of UNSW and able to independently use a washbasin then this study is for you.

### WHAT?

If you decide to take part, you will attend a test session at UNSW Sydney where you will;

- participate in a face-to-face interview about your washbasin experiences,
- have a series of body and reach measurements taken, and
  - perform simulated tasks at an adjustable washbasin.

The session will take approximately 3 hours to complete. A dedicated accessible parking space will be available for the session, an accessible bathroom is located near the lab and you may bring a carer or friend to the session. Staff will also be available to aid participants, if needed.
